SOME OF THE IMPACT WE'VE CREATED IN 2020 TO:



★ **817 indigenous producers** (487 indigenous women, 430 youth) ensured the protection and promotion of their local food heritage

★ We reached the amount of **3,513 gardens in Africa** in 35 countries

- 984 different kinds of food and 108 different varieties grown in 113 new gardens
- increased biodiversity and improved livelihood for 90% of the local communities around them

DEFEND BIOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL DIVERSITY

★ TERRA MADRE 2020

- 1,146 events
- in 75 countries
- reaching over 120,000 people

★ 45% of the respondents of the Terra Madre 2020 event declared they were new to Slow Food and **88% of them said they are willing to take action based on what they had learnt**



EDUCATE, INSPIRE AND MOBILIZE CITIZENS



INFLUENCE POLICIES IN THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTORS

★ Together with other civil society organisations, Slow Food launched a **petition to ban cages in animal farming**. As a result, **the European Commission has agreed to phase out cages for farmed animals across Europe**

★ The **Ugandan Land Grabbing Campaign** helped raise the voices of **peasant communities**, supporting them in having their land rights respected and building their capacity to expose and resist land grabbing initiatives, which led to public authorities respecting their rights to practice agroecology

★ Slow Food backed local communities with **more than 80 grassroots actions and initiatives in over 50 countries** all around the world, supporting them in alleviating the effects that the pandemic had on thousands of artisanal farmers and citizens in fragile contexts
